Diamond Club

The Diamond Club is a way of recognizing those clubs who are active and involved with their church and conference. Here are the requirements for membership in the Diamond Club.

- 1 – Registered with the conference and the Local Area by Dec 31 **
- 2 – Send in the monthly report by **the 15th** of the following month. 7 months out of the year must be turned in on time to receive this point
- 3 – Participate in Texas Camporee (if an International Camp year, participate in International Camp) **
- 4—Participate in PBE
- 5 – Participate in one non-PBE area event
- 6– Participate in an outreach event
- 7– Meet as a club at least twice a month (even if virtual meetings) An average of 20 meetings per year is required to meet this. Months to be considered are August-June. Not all months will have to have a report.
- 8– All Staff are Verified Volunteer certified **(letter from your local pastor or from YMMS must uploaded to the December report)** **

** = Proof such as screen shot, picture, receipt or letter must be uploaded when doing the report; therefore, be sure to have that available when reporting. This is to be uploaded to 1 monthly report per year. If your area has an event before this date, your club must register before participating in the area event.

Clubs that meet 7 of the 8 requirements are Diamond Club members at the silver level. Clubs that meet all 8, are Gold level members. Additionally, if a club meets all 8 and has at least one club member who is a non-Adventist from a non-Adventist family, they will be recognized as a Diamond Elite. So, to recap-

Diamond Silver 7 of 8

Diamond Gold all 8

Diamond Elite all 8 plus non-Adventist member

It is our hope that all Texas Conference clubs will strive to be Diamond Club members.
